artistic project of the host organisation

- **fields of expression proposed for the residency:**

Jazz composition, with the option of performance with or without local musicians.

- **description the general artistic project of your structure:**

The Hot Club de Portugal is a non-profit organisation for the development of Jazz music in Portugal. It includes a Jazz club, a school, and several groups, both professional and student level (big band, etc.). It promotes concerts, workshops and other activities in this field.

- **particular frame offered for this residency:**

The proposed residency considers final performances with local musicians (if necessary) at the Hot Club (well-known Jazz club), at the school and, possibly, at other venues as well.

- **the means of encouraging exchanges among different forms of expression:**

The Hot Clube will establish protocols with other institutions, and including those exchanges in their regular activities. For instance, the Hot Club has an on-going project with the Superior Dance School of Lisbon, and a performance with original works by students of both schools is held every year.

- **the means of fostering interactions with the human, social and economic contexts:**

The Hot Clube will help the candidate to integrate in the Lisboa music scene at all levels: musically, personally and socially.

- **human resources which will enable the artist to develop his project:**

The project will be supervised by the board of directors of the Jazz school. Musicians will be available from time to time for readings within the school community (teachers and/or students). The manager of the club, Mr. Luis Hilário, will be in charge of the musical production regarding concerts.

- **material resources which will be available for the artist:**

The school has a computer room, apart from classrooms and rehearsal rooms with piano, amplifiers and drums.

- **ways of promoting the artistic work:**

The performances will be advertised at the usual monthly brochure with the concerts at the club. Also with a national press release, destined to all media and music schools.

description of the residency

- **description of the professional and artistic environment of the structure:**

The Hot Club Jazz School has some of the finest professional jazz musicians in Portugal, many of them former students. It doesn't promote any particular style of improvised music in special. Different students, as well as different teachers are often interested in developing their work in different directions.

- **description of the local environment and the standard of living:**

Lisbon is the capital of Portugal, and has about 1, 5 million inhabitants. The club is very central, near Avenida da Liberdade, one of the city's main avenues, and the school is facing river Tejo, with good transportation nearby, and about 15 mn from the city center.

- **description of the means of accommodation and the distance from the working place:**

Single room in a hotel located in the center, or a small apartment.

- **amount of the grant (monthly):**

750 EUR are allowed to the artist each month.
